SHIF Telehealth Claims in the Age of COVID – Artemis Reporting

The below is an overview of key observations of Telemedicine claims data in the half of the 2020-2021 SHIF Fund year, 7/1/2020 - 12/31/2020 as compared to 7/1/2019 - 12/31/2019.

General Telehealth Trends

- 22% of the SHIF population, 9,255 individuals, actively enrolled in an Aetna or AHA plan incurred a telehealth claim in the July-December 2020 period.
- 61% of that group were female.
- Subscribers topped the relationship code that utilized telehealth the most:
 - Subscriber -46%Dependent 32Spouse 22%

Telehealth Visit Volume and Financial Metrics

- With only 646 telehealth visits processed in Q3 and Q4 2019 claims data comparing 30,105 claims processed in Q3 and Q 4 of 2020, the SHIF saw an increase in utilization of over **4,000%**.
- The allowed amount for all processed/paid telehealth claims was \$26,000 in 2019 and \$3.3MM in 2020.
- The PEPM allowed amount in 2020 was \$39, while the PEPM Fund paid amount was \$43.50. The average by claim paid amount was \$122
- **Teladoc** was the top provider for telemedicine claims, with **797 claims** incurred in the first half of the 2020-2021 SHIF Fund year. Center for Family Guidance was a distant second with 279 distinct claims occurring.
 - Claims to Teladoc and MDLive process with \$0 member cost share for those enrolled in non-HDHP plans. Members who utilize providers other than Teladoc and MDLive are assessed standard plan cost share.
- The top diagnosis for all telehealth claims was anxiety and stress disorders, with 1,686 distinct claims. This diagnosis also led the Fund for net paid amount, with \$1.18MM in paid claims.
- For **telehealth visits to a PCP**, the top ICD10 for claim counts was *persons with a potential health hazard due to communicative diseases*. This also led the diagnoses list for employer paid, with \$257,000 net paid.

Behavioral Health Telehealth Claims Key Observations:


- In the first half of the 2020-2021 Fund year, **10,571** members of the SHIF had a behavioral health telehealth claim processed. With a head count of 40,600, that is **26%** of the membership. This is a **130%** increase from Q3 and Q4 of 2019.
- Behavioral health telehealth claims contributed **\$3.97MM** to the total net paid for the Fund in the first half of the 2020-2021 Fund year.
- July 2020 was the largest month for count of processed telehealth claims in Qs 3 and 4 of 2020. Another spike occurred in October.
- The PEPM allowed amount in 2020 was \$79, while the PEPM Fund paid amount was \$91. The average by claim paid amount was \$191
- The top diagnosis for **all behavioral health telehealth claims** was *anxiety and stress disorders*, with 2,594 members with this diagnosis code. This diagnosis also led the Fund for net paid amount, with \$1.18MM in paid claims.

Next Steps:


- Both Aetna's TelaDoc and AmeriHealth's MDLive telemedine programs have a

 will conduct a cost analysis and review financial impact of adding these services to our existing
 TelaDoc and MDLive offerings.
- Engage Guardian Nurses with data set and review potential program offerings








Telehealth Visit Volume + Financial Metrics



YoY Trend - Allowed Amount (Med)


